
WELCOME TO HOLYWELL TOWN FC

HOW TO FIND US

By Car

Located just off the A55 expressway. Free parking is available at the ground, with additional spaces nearby at the pay and display car park opposite the hospital. If using **PayByPhone**, the car park ID is **807110 - Halkyn Road**.

By Train

The nearest station is Flint, around 5 miles away, with bus and taxi links into Holywell. 25 min bus ride, 10-15 mins by car.

By Bus

Local buses run from Flint and Mold into Holywell town centre, a short walk to the stadium.

FACILITIES

Total capacity: 2,000

Seating is available across all three stands, with open terracing around the remainder of the pitch to keep supporters close to the action. Away supporters are welcome throughout the ground with no segregation in place.

Clubhouse & Bar

A warm welcome awaits in the clubhouse, serving hot food, snacks, and a fully licensed bar. **Cash & Card accepted.**

Cafe

Small cafe situated in far side of main stand selling drinks and snacks. **Cash & Card accepted.**

Toilets

Located in the main stand and clubhouse. Disabled toilet in the clubhouse.

Accessibility

Step-free access around the ground.

Pet friendly

Pets are welcome at the ground and remain the responsibility of their owners at all times.



MATCH DAYS

Holywell are renowned for passionate home support, often among the top attendances in the league. The covered stands are lively, and the tight layout makes for a proper match atmosphere where you're never far from the pitch. The entrance is via the turnstile as you walk up the main drive through the main gates.

ALCOHOL RESTRICTIONS

Supporters can enjoy a drink on matchdays, but only in the designated areas inside the ground. Once you move past these points, alcohol is not permitted. Staff will guide you if you are unsure where the boundaries are.

We ask everyone to follow the rules so the club stays compliant and matchdays stay relaxed for everyone. If you have any questions, just ask a steward.



